Hello Faculty,



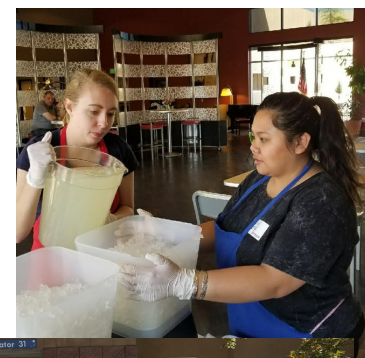

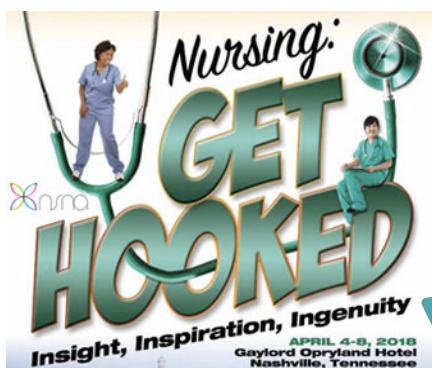
